PSALMS OF LENT | Psalm 130

STEPPING INTO FULL LIGHT | vs. 3-4

If you, God, kept records on wrongdoings, who would stand a chance?
As it turns out, forgiveness is your habit, and that's why you're feared (revered in relationship).

A VISION OF THE END | vs. 5-6

I pray to GoD—my life a prayer and wait for what he'll say and do. My soul waits for the Lord, more than watchmen for the morning, more than watchmen for the morning.

HOPE TO LIVE BY | vs. 7-8

O Israel, wait and watch for God—with God's arrival comes love, with God's arrival comes generous redemption. No doubt about it—he'll redeem Israel, buy back Israel from captivity to sin.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Use verses 3-4 to let the Spirit lead you into the light beyond the darkness of "the old's" death. Pray them until you believe them.
- 2) Then ask the Spirit to use verses 5-6 to evoke, and bring to mind an image, feeling, or memory of life beyond the end of the old that is a life worth living into.

Consider: What vision of redemption, new life, is the Spirit leading you to watch, wait and hope for, and live into?

&

Candidly Pray from the place of sight of the end.

3) When you are ready, let the final verses be a prayer that draws you to the table prepared for you. Allow these words be a prayer not for something future but for something already done, and so, a hope that you can live by.
